**MOTION FOR EXTENSION  
TO FILE PETITION FOR RATE INCREASE**


Captain's Cove Utility Company, Inc. ("CCUC"), by counsel, moves the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an extension to file a petition for a rate increase, and in support of its motion, states as follows.

1. On June 17, 2010, the Commission entered an Order and Rule to Show Cause directing CCUC to appear and show cause regarding its financial status.
2. The Commission conducted a hearing on June 23, 2010, took evidence, and received representations from counsel for the Commission staff, CCUC and the Captain's Cove Golf and Yacht Club, Inc. (the "Association").
3. CCUC represented that it had obtained funding for the continued operation of the utility, contingent upon the granting of an emergency rate increase.
4. The Commission continued the case to allow CCUC to work with Commission staff and the Association and thereafter file a petition for emergency rate increase on or before June 30, 2010.

5. Following the hearing, CCUC met with staff, the Association and funding sources regarding the process and need for a rate increase.
6. While a rate increase will be necessary for CCUC, and it is the expectation that a rate increase will be diligently pursued and reviewed, the contingency of a July 1, 2010 rate increase has been removed by the lender.
7. CCUC anticipates mailing out its standard billing on July 1, 2010 in accordance with its current approved tariff for the second quarter of 2010. Proceeds from the July billing would be used to maintain operations.
8. Accordingly, CCUC requests that it be allowed an extension to August 6, 2010 to file a petition and/or notice of rate increase for CCUC.
9. CCUC will maintain all normal and customary operations in the interim, and has assurances of sufficient financing to provide for pumper trucks for the upcoming holiday weekend. CCUC has made arrangements for the payment of all operation critical expenses and past due invoices.
10. CCUC is assured of financing to allow it to maintain the current level of service pending a petition and/or notice of rate increase made on or before August 6, 2010 followed by timely review and hearing if and as necessary.

WHEREFORE, Captain's Cove Utility Co., Inc., prays that the Commission extend the time for Captain's Cove Utility Co., Inc. to file a rate increase to on or before August 6, 2010 and grant such other and further relief as justice may require.


