After conversations with the Department of Health and the State Corporation Commission, I participated yesterday in a conference call for over an hour with representatives from the State Corporation Commission, Department of Environmental Quality, state and local Health Departments, the Attorney General's office, and regional representatives of the Department of Environmental Quality. There was an in depth discussion of the current situation. The call was organized by Commissioner of Health Remley. It was clear from that conference call that all of the necessary state agencies are very much focused on the situation at Captain's Cove, and further focused on protecting the health and safety of the residents there. While there is no perfect solution to this very serious situation, after that conference call, and a further follow up with county government and a discussion with Supervisor Wolff, I continue to feel secure in regard to the health and safety of the residents of Captain's Cove. While these are tense times and this is a serious situation, I believe we have the attention and resolve of the necessary agencies of the Commonwealth to protect the health and safety of the citizens of Captain's Cove.

This is an ongoing effort, and the group will continue to closely monitor the situation and share information and ideas going forward.
