Happenings in the Cove

The Board of Directors and the Association Staff are working hard to improve communication throughout our Community and with non-resident Property Owners. We are moving towards a new interactive website. In the mean time, we have been assembling an email list that is used only to communicate Captains Cove activities to our Membership. There is a General Manager's Forum scheduled for Saturday April 11, 2009. We will be at the Marina Club at 10am. We will be available to answer questions and to receive suggestions from Member's of the Association. Captain's Cove Utility Company will be giving a presentation on our drinking water and will also be taking questions.

The Board has adopted three new rules by resolution and the Membership must be notified of these rules before they can be enforced. This mailing, going to all Property Owners, shall serve as such notice. The three rules passed

concern: Collection Policy, Rules Enforcement, and Property Transfers. This is an update of current Collection Policy and an update on Rules Enforcement Policy. The Property Transfer Fee is a replacement for the Initial Capital Contribution Fee that was adopted in 2004. These policy updates will allow the Association Staff to have clearer direction on issues of Collection and Rules Enforcement. The Property Transfer Fee is to cover expenses occurred by the Association when new property owners are added to the Community.

Our busy season is right around the corner. We look forward to an exciting year here at Captain's Cove. Our Community has so much to offer, and we hope that you are all here to enjoy YOUR Community.

April is here, time to get in gear. The new flounder regulations for 2009 have been finalized. This year we will be looking at a 5 fish limit with a minimum length of 19" and no closed season. You still have a little time to get prepared, as the flounder fishing in Chincoteague Bay usually doesn't peak until later in April. If you need any service work on boating or fishing equipment, go ahead and get it done, because waiting will only make the

lines longer. Beat the rush, make sure those important safety items such as flares aren't outdated and that all lifejackets are in good shape. VMRC and the Coast Guard will be doing safety checks on the water, so go ahead and make sure your equipment is ready. Hope to see everybody April 25 & 26 for the Flounder Tournament. 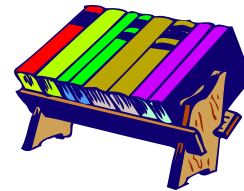
