As many of you are aware, the biggest issue facing the community today is Captains Cove Group, LLC's pending bankruptcy case, and their negotiations with Captains Cove Golf & Yacht Club, Inc. The Board of Directors has been negotiating with the Developer since January, when they were presented with the opportunity to purchase some or all of the Developer's Assets. Any deal that could be made would be subject to a vote of the Membership. The Board of Directors does not have authority to finance such a large expenditure without approval of the Membership. The Board is currently engaged in "due diligence" and is evaluating the value of assets that are of high importance to the community. These assets have been divided into three

categories; lots, the Utility Company, and The Marina Club. Quoting Board President Wilbur Bowden, "The Board will assemble the available options, and present them to the membership." The Board's primary concern is protecting the assets and equities of the Membership, as well as preserving the lifestyle enjoyed here at Captain's Cove.

In The Cove, we are busy preparing for another season. Work has begun on the swimming pools. The pool at Town Center will be open this year, along with the new pool at the Marina Club. I have finally seen the wading pool at the Marina Club in action, and the young children will be sure to love the "Mushroom Fountain." The Restaurant is in full swing, and the deck is going to be a great place to enjoy a cool beverage on a summer afternoon. We hope that everyone gets to enjoy a great Summer Season in Captains Cove.

Here is an update on the CERT Spring Health and Safety Fair on May 9, 2009 from 10 am to 2 pm at the Marina Club.

There will be representatives from the Accomack County Health Department, The Sheriff's Department, the County Emergency Management Department, Greenbackville Fire and Ambulance, Captain's Cove Security, Neighborhood Watch, and CERT, as well as the exercise classes that are available at the Marina Club. We will also have representatives from the Delmarva Blood Bank, Coast Guard Auxiliary, American Red Cross, Peninsula Regional Hospital Health and

Wellness Community and Atlantic General Hospital Education Department. Most of these groups will have information available on public health and safety issues. We will have some demonstrations, such as CPR and use of Defibrillator equipment, some health screenings, and storm preparedness and evacuation. There will be handouts available.

We hope this event will be beneficial for adults and children of our Cove community. Please come out and support your Community Emergency Response Team (CERT). We look forward to seeing you there.
